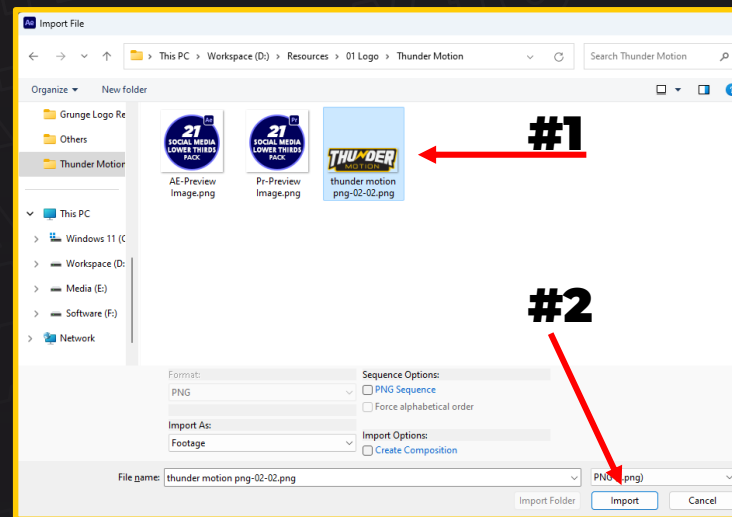
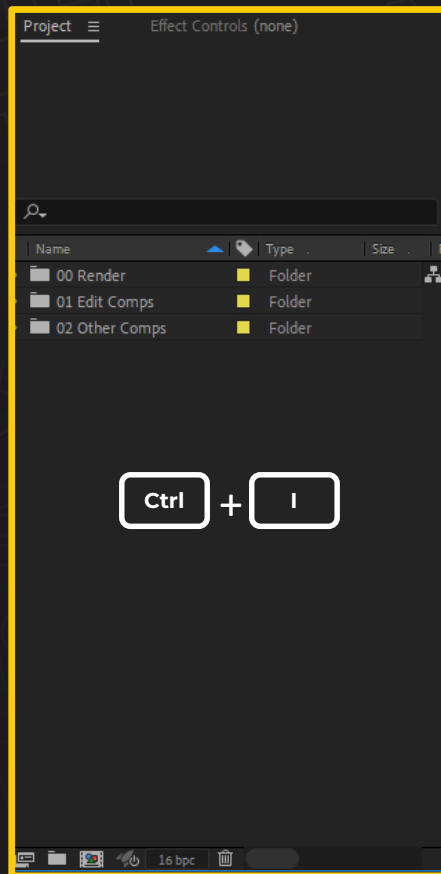


How to import your file?

Press "Ctrl+I"

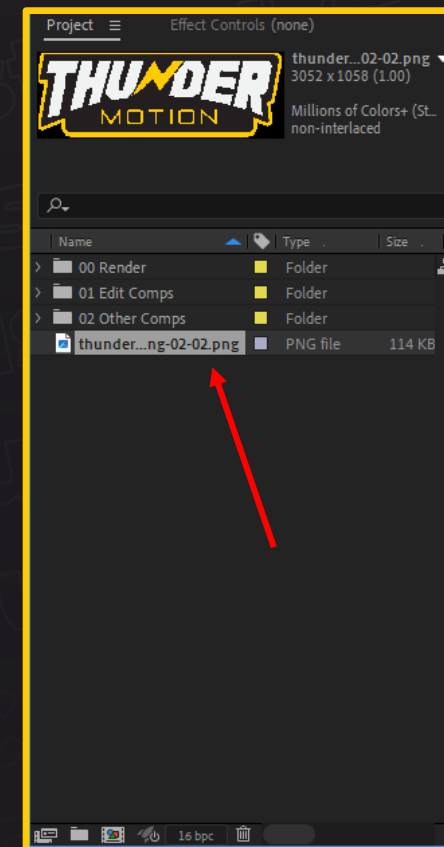


Click on project tab

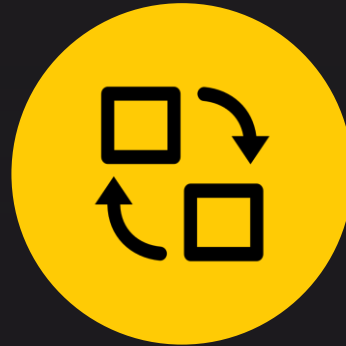


Then select your media and press import

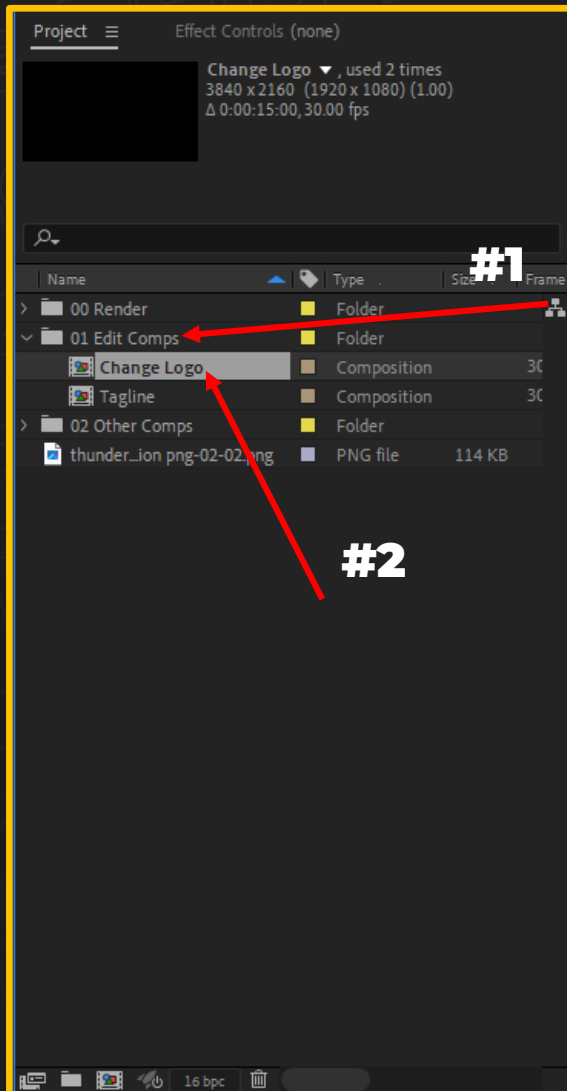
Your will see your media here



STEP 02

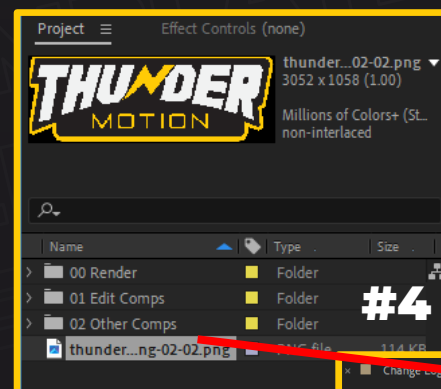
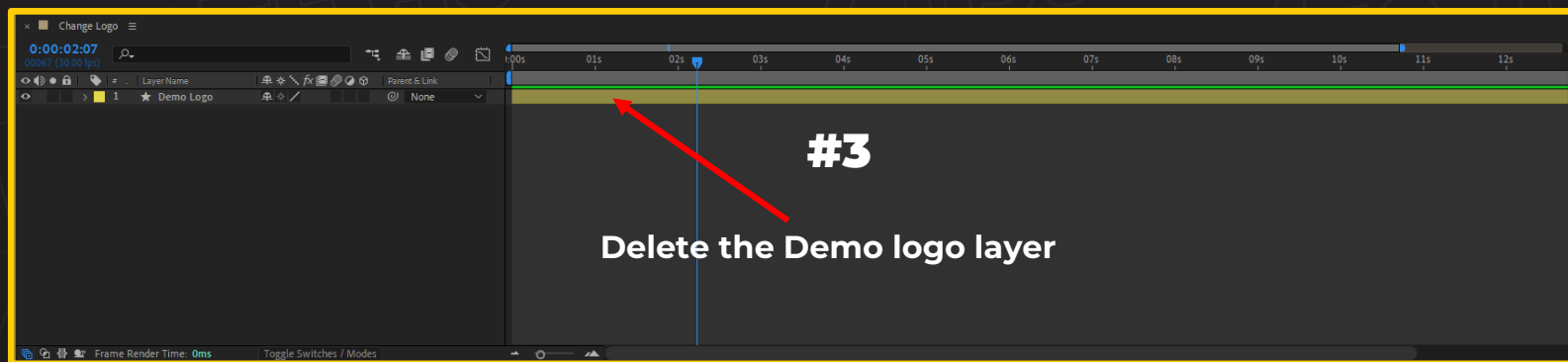


How to replace your logo or image?

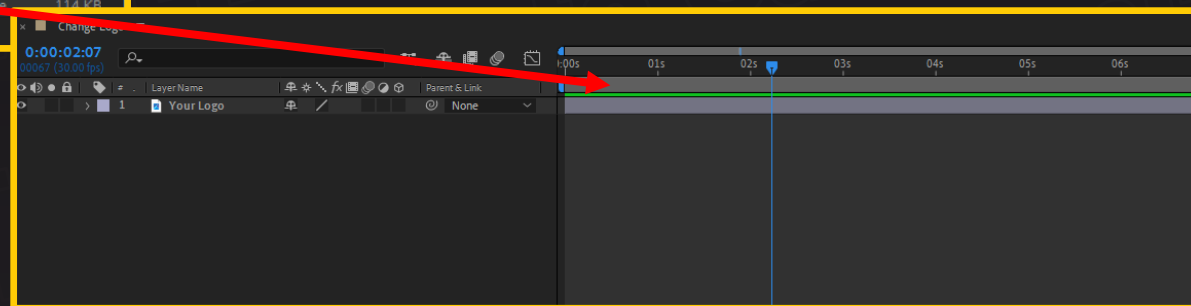


First, click on “edit comp” folder and then double click on “change logo” composition

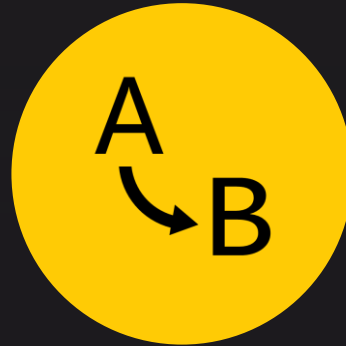
You will see the “change logo” composition Has been opened on the timeline panel



Then Drag Your Media or Logo from Project Panel to Timeline

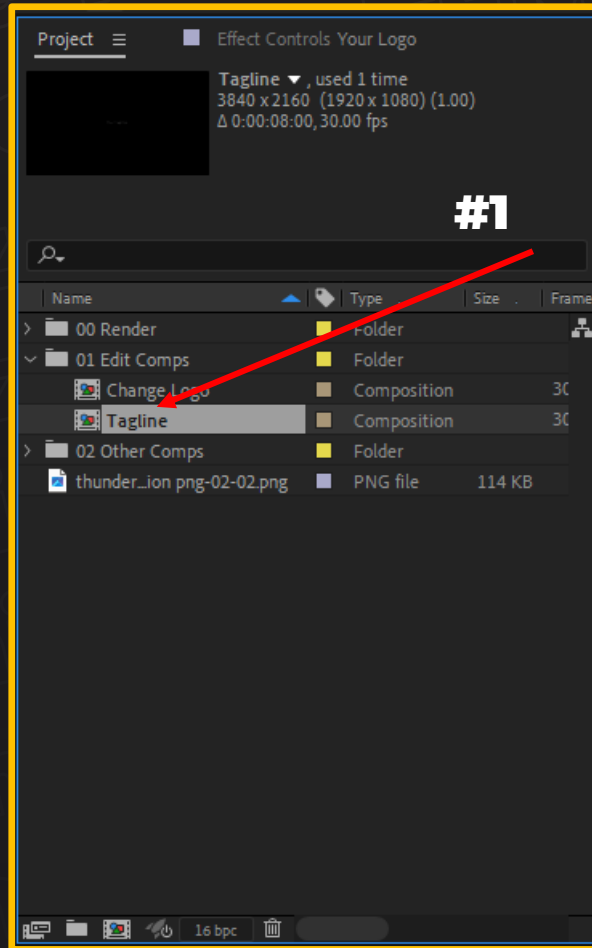

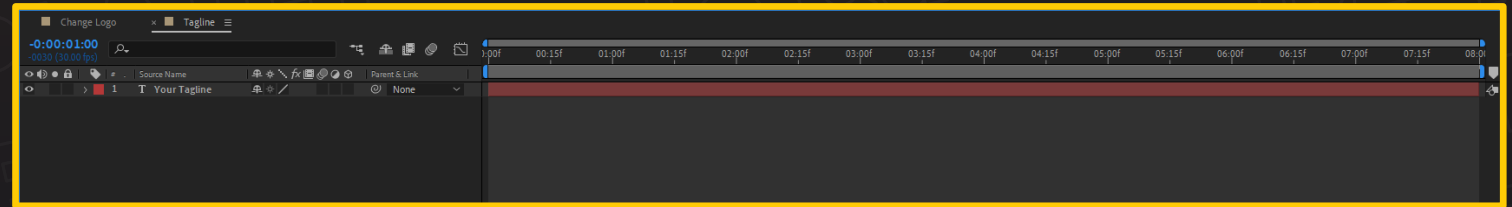


How to replace the text or tagline?

You will see the “Tagline” composition has been opened on the timeline panel

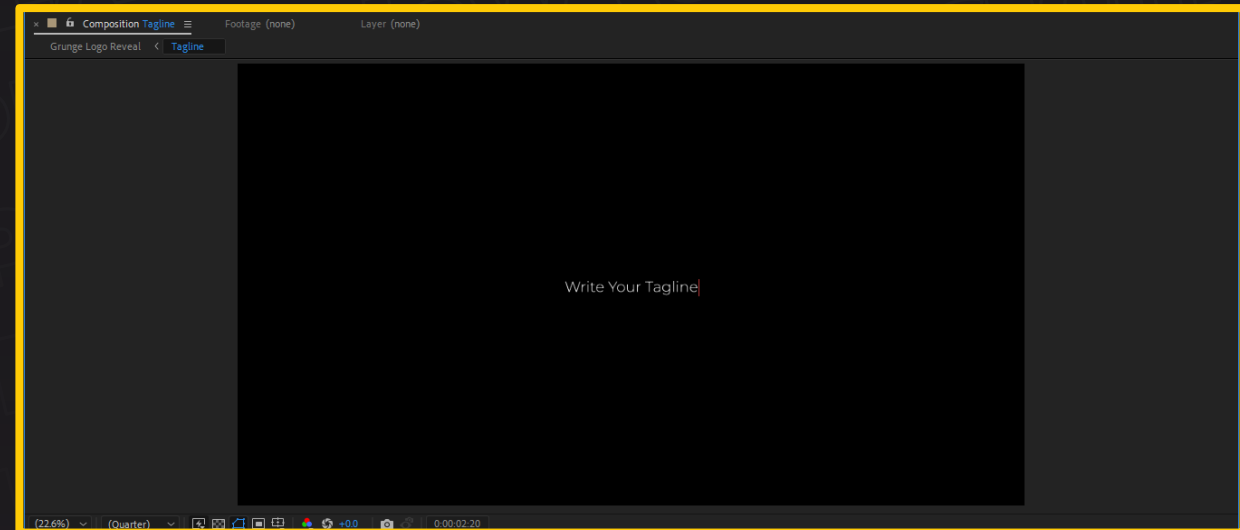

double click on the “Tagline” composition

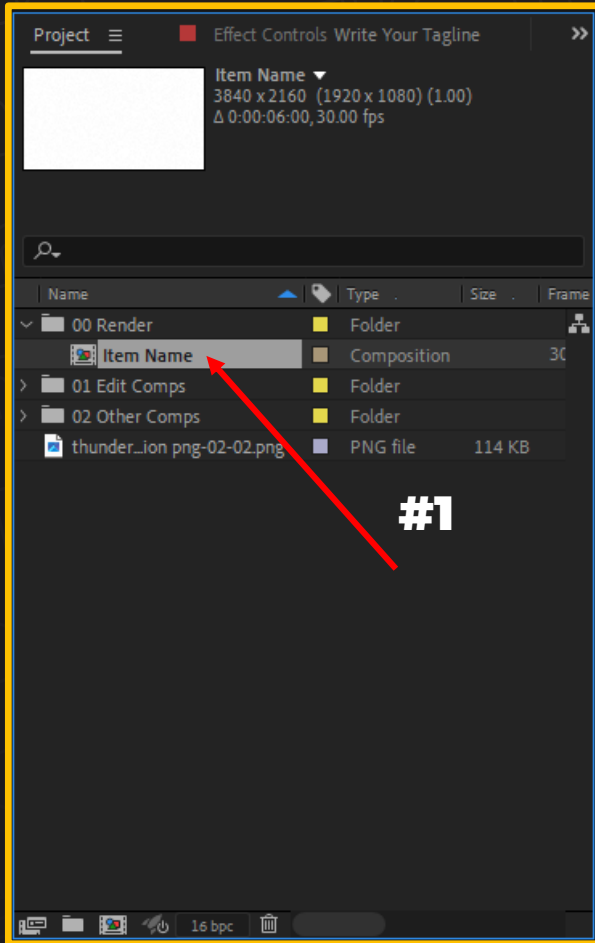
Then click on the text layer on timeline and Composition panel write your text

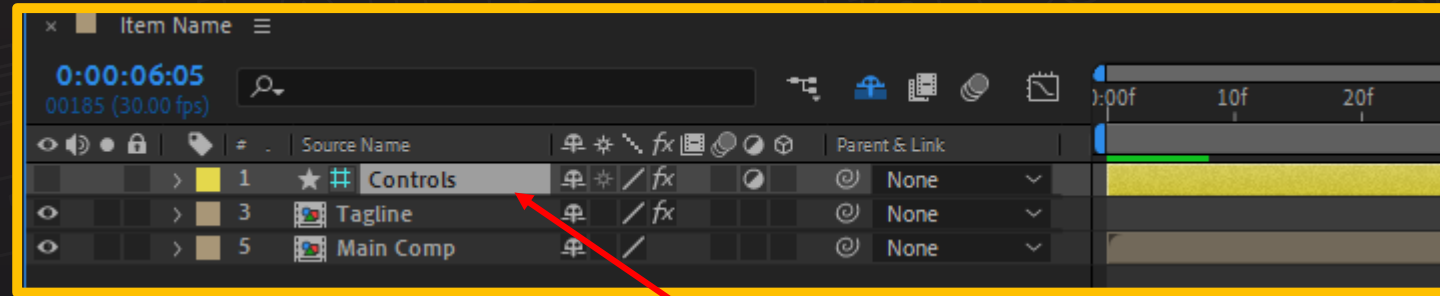
How to customize color, size, and position?

You will see the “Render” composition has been opened on the timeline panel



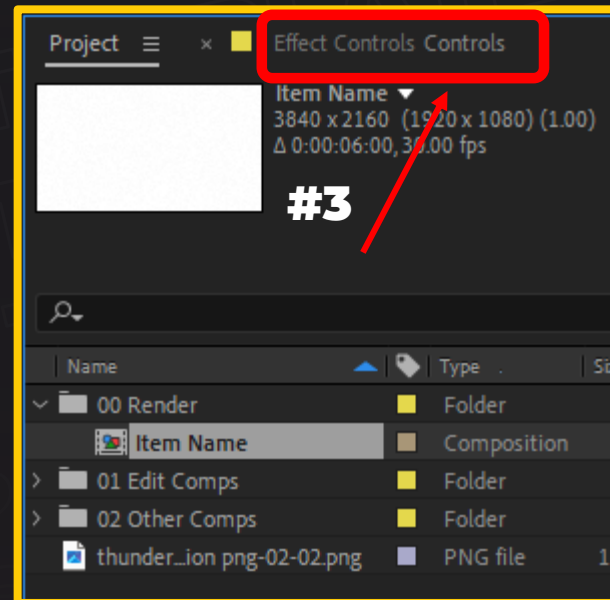

Now click on the “Render” folder and then double click on the composition



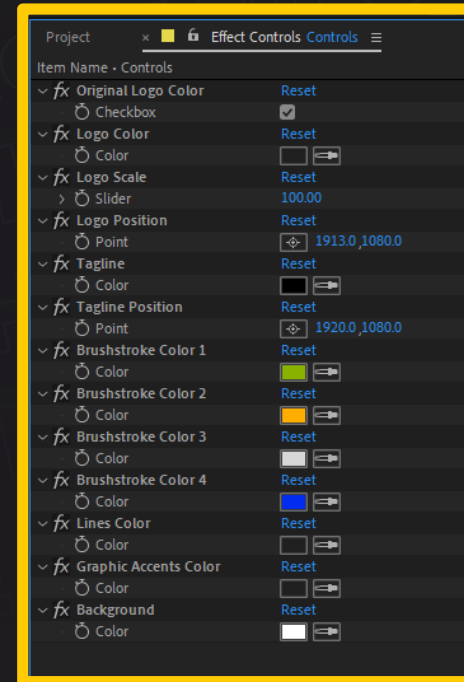
Then click on the “Controls” layer

Now On the Project Panel click on Effect Controls

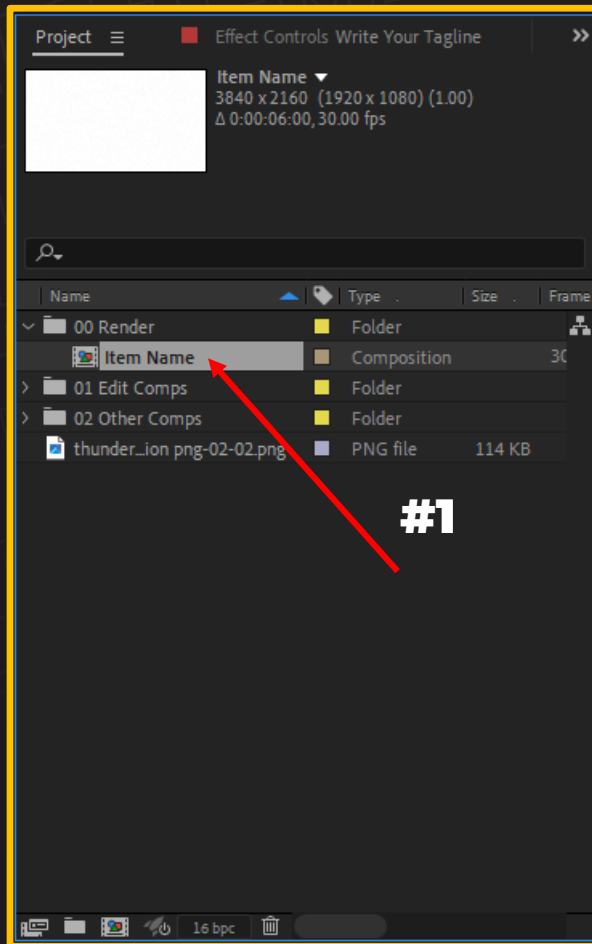


On the Effect Controls Panel You will find all the settings to Change color, size, and position

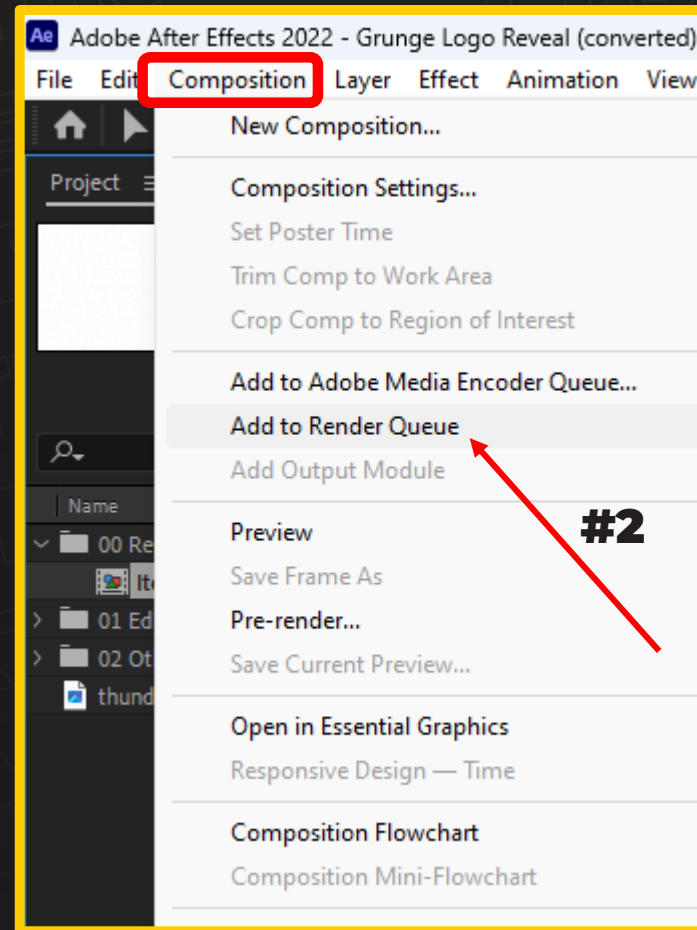
STEP 05



How to render or export your final file?

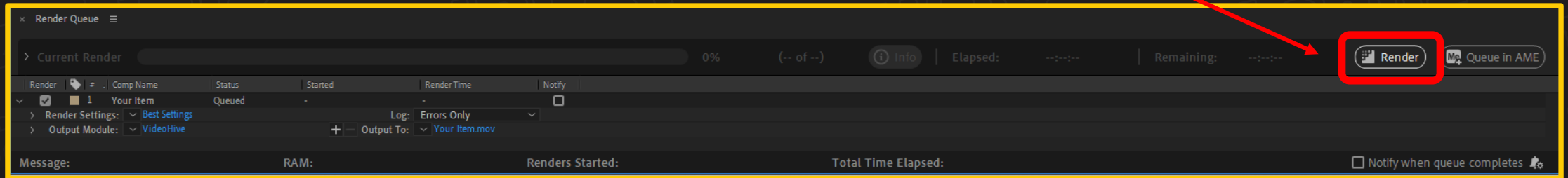


First, click on the “Render” folder and then Select the composition



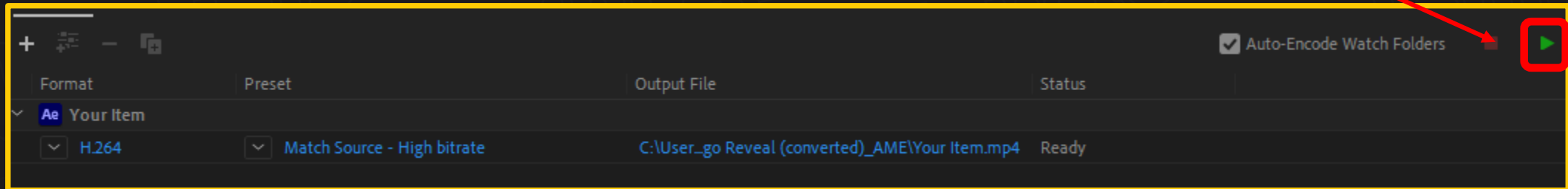
Then, click on the composition and then Add to Render Queue or Media Encoder Queue to render
